We will address intergenerational challenges with continuous intergenerational support, committing to the long-term support. We will foster meaningful change through whānau empowerment, preferencing prevention over intervention.

We will form long-term relationships with vulnerable tamariki and their whanau as they progress through their schooling into early adulthood. We will grow the wellbeing and resilience of the community by raising their aspirations for themselves and their whānau.

This will mean:

- Vulnerable Tamarki leveraging the full range of educational and vocational opportunities open to them.
- Parents being supported to be the very best they can be for their whanau.
- Prosocial engagement with the larger community, valuing culture, diversity, and inclusion.
- Thriving local communities: vibrant, resilient, and connected.

Because in Aotearoa New Zealand no one should be left behind. We need the creativity, culture, and ingenuity of every one of us to tackle the complex challenges ahead.




In July 2023, we launched our first full pilot phase with the employment of our first whānau support worker who is based at our existing Opportunity Hub at Gilberthorpe School.
